How to apply

Requirements

- 1. Be an active MTBO orienteer.
- 2. Have competed in countries other than your own.
- 3. Have successfully controlled major national events in the last 3 years.
- 4. Be competent in the English language.
- 5. Have attended, and have been an active participant in, an IOF Event Advisers Clinic

- 6. Be familiar with the following IOF Publications:
 - Competition Rules for MTB Orienteering Events
 - International Specifications for MTB Orienteering Maps
 - World Ranking Events Handbook
- 7. Be recognised as a top standard controller/event adviser and endorsed as suitable by your Federation

Accreditation and Re-accreditation

- Apply using the MTBO EA Accreditation Form
 - The form must be endorsed and submitted by your Federation!
 - Re-Accreditation is required every two years
 - **REQUIREMENTS FOR STAYING ON THE LIST OF IOF EVENT ADVISERS:**
 1. Have successfully been an event adviser/controller at an international or major national event in the last three years.*
 2. Have the continued endorsement of your Federation.
- * This requirement may be waived on a once only basis if you have organised a event advisers' / controllers' Clinic or played a leading role in the organisation of major events in the last three years **and** continue to have your Federation's endorsement.
