Mapping standards

- Review of ISMTBOM is in hands of Map Commission
- First step: only most urgently needed symbols
- Symbols will be available soon
- Testing phase starts then
- Updated ISMTBOM by January 2020

- Compulsory to use at World Cup events (as from January 2018):
contactless system with a range of 1.50 – 1.80 m
→ at the moment only SPORTident Air+
- Backup SI Active Card
(only in case of main SIAC's failure)
